Cancellation and Responsibility Policy

CANCELLATIONS

All cancellations must be received **in writing** by **U.S. Junior Tours Inc.** On the business day that cancellation materials are received by U.S. Junior Tours, the following schedule of refunds/fees will apply.

Notice of cancellation received:

- 91 or more days prior to departure, a full refund will be made less a cancellation fee of \$500.00 (deposit) plus funds irrecoverable (i.e. airfare, accommodations, greens fees, ground transportation, sightseeing and attractions etc.)
- 61-90 days prior to departure, \$500.00 (deposit) and 40% of the total land cost is non-refundable, plus funds irrecoverable (i.e. airfare, accommodations, greens fees, ground transportation, sightseeing and attractions etc.)
- 31-60 days prior to departure, \$500.00 (deposit) and 60% of the total land cost is non-refundable, plus funds irrecoverable (i.e. airfare, accommodations, greens fees, ground transportation, sightseeing and attractions etc.)
- 11-30 days prior to departure, \$500.00 (deposit) and 80% of the total land cost is non-refundable, plus funds irrecoverable (i.e. airfare, accommodations, greens fees, ground transportation, sightseeing and attractions etc.)

Participants canceling 10 days prior to departure or later will be subject to 100% forfeiture of all funds paid. Cancellation includes, but is not limited to, any voluntary withdrawal from the program 10 days prior to departure or later and any removal from the program 10 days prior to departure or later.

Upon cancellation of the transportation or travel services, where the customer is not at fault and have not canceled in violation of the terms and conditions of the contract for transportation or travel services, all sums paid to **U.S. Junior Tours Inc.** for services not received by you will be promptly refunded by **U.S. Junior Tours Inc.** to you unless you otherwise advise **U.S. Junior Tours Inc.** in writing.

PLEASE NOTE: The processing of refunds usually cannot be completed until 45 days after the conclusion of a program in order to determine the amount of irrecoverable funds.

U.S. Junior Tours Inc., organizer of the program, its agents and/or suppliers of service, expressly disclaims and shall be held free of all responsibility or liability for any act, error, omission, injury, loss, accident, delay or the neglect or default of any company or person providing any service for this program, or due to epidemic, social or political or military disturbances, or due to any cause whatsoever occurring during this program. **U.S. Junior Tours Inc.** reserves the right to withdraw, or cancel the tour at any time before its commencement and full refund of monies paid by program purchaser and/or program participant shall be the full limit of **U.S. Junior Tours Inc.** liability to said purchaser and/or program participant; or to substitute, when expedient or necessary, aircraft, airlines, hotels; or to cancel a program purchaser and/or program participant from the program prior to, after the commencement of, or during the program; and to make such substitutions, alterations, or cancellations at any time without any advance notice to or approval of program purchaser and/or program participant. No refund will be made for any unused portions of any program unless such portion has been deleted from the tour, or said participant has been canceled and the pro rata cost to such unused portion shall be the full limit of **U.S. Junior Tours Inc.** responsibility to said program purchaser and/or program participant. Simply complete a Family Member Program Application and Medical Authorization Form. Return these forms along with a \$500.00 per person non-refundable deposit to reserve a spot.

This program entitles travelers to everything listed in the tour program with the exception of golf and **U.S. Junior Tours'** clothing. Golf can be arranged, including balloting for the Old Course. **U.S. Junior Tours'** clothing is available and may be purchased separately.

Family program members may be added to the tour any time up to 45 days prior to departure, subject to availability. In order to ensure a confirmed spot on the trip, we strongly recommend sending your registration forms and deposit within the participant's 14-day deadline. Late additions must meet the payment schedule effective on date of registration with the program.

Tour Price does not include:

Meals, other than specified; passport and visa fees; transportation to/from gateway city; airport taxes, telephone, laundry, optional sightseeing and tips to guides and drivers, or other items of a strictly personal nature. Prices in this proposal are based on tariffs and exchange rates in effect today and are subject to change without notice. Tour itineraries and cities are also subject to change.
